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## Welcome to NUR 214 – Nursing Care of the Adult and Child II

The focus of this course is on the basic needs of clients and the use of the nursing process to promote wellness, prevent illness and manage responses to identified actual or potential health problems. Topics include those related to chronic illness, excretion (renal), immune response, metabolism (hepatic), movement and sensation (neurologic), oxygenation and terminal illness. The core components of associate degree nursing practice (Professional Behaviors, Communication, Assessment, Clinical Decision Making, Therapeutic Nursing Interventions, Collaboration, Teaching/Learning, Managing Care) are expanded and integrated into clinical practice.
